



2017 SUMMER PROGRAM APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

ELIGIBILITY

- (1) Academic restrictions: college student or above.
- (2) Age restrictions: 18 or older. If the applicant has just graduated from high school, he or she must have already been admitted to university.

REQUIREMENTS

- (1) **Application form.**
- (2) **ID Photo:** To make your student ID card, please submit a high-resolution photo in JPEG, JPG or PNG format.
- (3) **Statement of purpose:** Please describe your personal, academic, and career plans. Why do you want to study Chinese at ICLP? What can ICLP do to help you attain your academic and career goals?
- (4) **Résumé or curriculum vitae:** All formats are accepted. Be sure to include the following information: name, contact information, education, employment, achievements, skills, and qualifications.
- (5) **Course history (prior learning experience in Chinese): List all the Chinese language courses or courses taught in Chinese that you have taken in the past. Include the following information:**
 - Full name of applicant
 - Level of course (include course name and number)
 - Institution and dates for each course
 - Names of instructors
 - Class hours per week
 - Textbooks used and extent to which the content of the text was covered
 - Indicate whether you will require textbooks and handouts in simplified characters
 - Language Proficiency test scores or other Languages and proficiency level

If you are a beginner, there is no need to include the course history with your application. Please indicate that you are a beginner on the application form.

- (6) **Transcripts:** Either a hardcopy or PDF transcript is acceptable.
- (7) **References:** Two references are required. You can download the reference form on the ICLP website. Please have your referees complete, sign and send the letters to ICLP via mail/email.
- (8) **Non-refundable application fee of US\$100.** ICLP is unable to waive or defer the application fee. No application will be processed without the application fee. The following forms of payment are accepted: bank/wire transfers, personal check, bank draft, postal money order, American Express traveler's check, or cash. Please find the bank details and check notice as below.

Notes:

- Please include **applicant name** and **ICLP** in the transfer payment details. The above accounts are shared by all National Taiwan University (NTU) units. Therefore, if NTU is unable to identify which unit or student the transfer is intended for, the payment will not be processed.
- Please ensure that the exact amount is received by ICLP. The **remitter** is responsible for **all bank charges**, including the intermediary bank fees. Hua Nan Commercial Bank charges NT\$200 (approximately US\$7) for receiving transfers. Banks in the United States generally charge US\$50 for processing transfers.
- Submit **proof of payment** (e.g. bank receipt) to ICLP via email or fax as soon as you complete the transfer. Email: iclp@ntu.edu.tw Fax: +886 2 23626926
- Allow up to 7 business days for the transfer to be received by Hua Nan Bank and for NTU to process the payment.
- ICLP will email confirmation upon receipt of the payment.



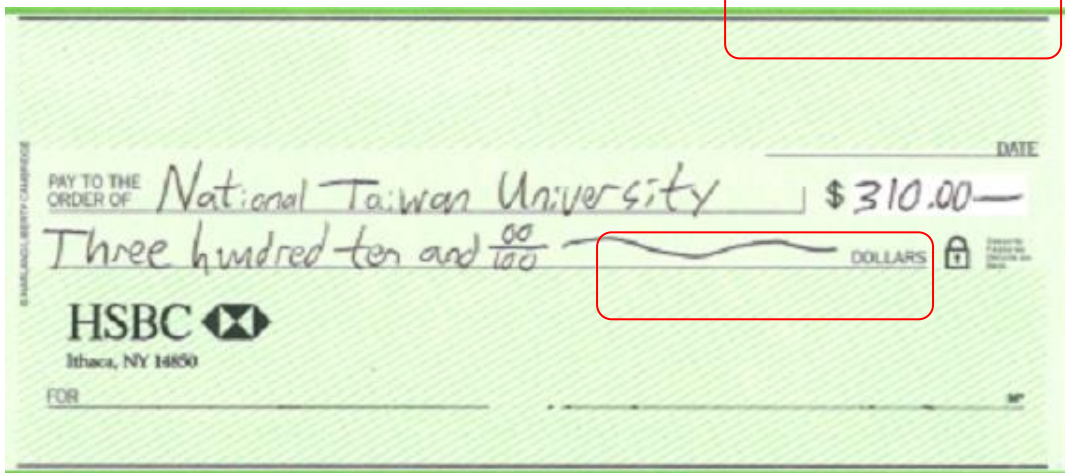
CHECK NOTICE

Make the check payable to *National Taiwan University*.

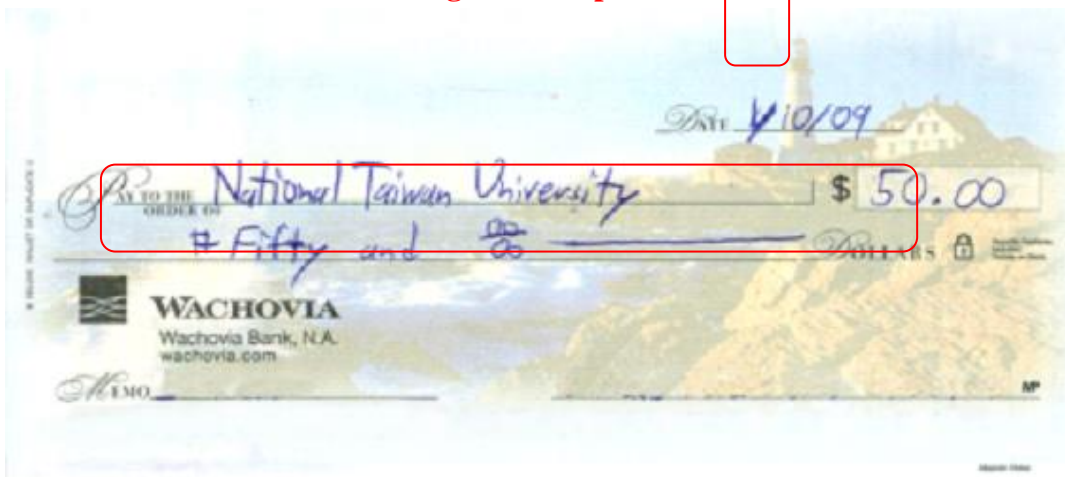
- Neither the slightest correction nor abbreviations are accepted. Please make sure that all words are spelled out. Refer to the examples below before mailing your check.
- The date on the check must be written in the order of **MM/DD/YYYY**. If the date must be written in the **DD/MM/YYYY** format, please make sure that the month is spelled out. For example, 02/10/2016 should be written as 02 October 2016.
- National Taiwan University only accepts U.S. currency issued in or after 1997. No U.S. currency with the series number beginning with “CB” will be accepted. The following major currencies are accepted: euro, Japanese yen, and pound sterling. Only banknotes in mint condition are accepted. Any banknote with pinholes and/or staple holes, markings, stains, or tears will be rejected.
- New Taiwan dollar is also accepted. The application fee in NTD is 3,000.

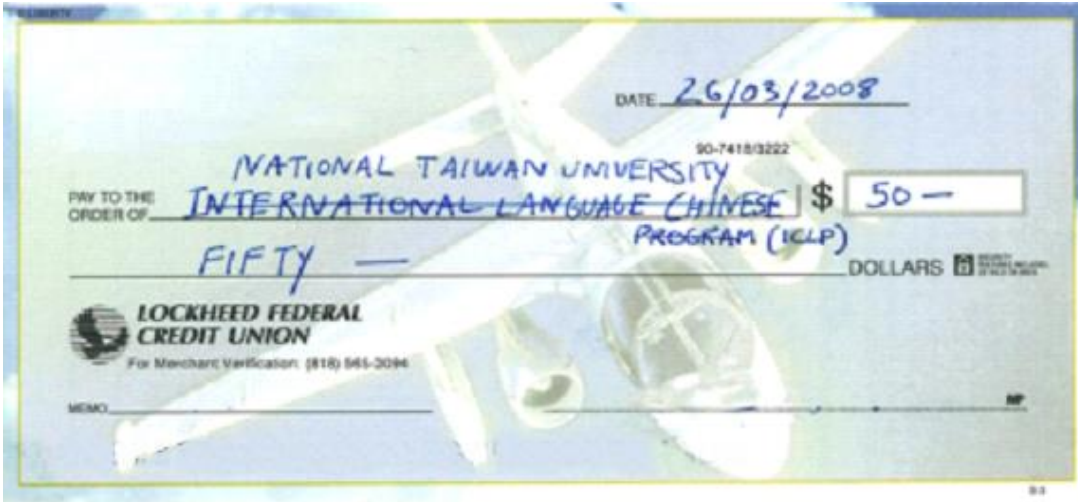
