

Track Selection for 2020 Summer Program

In response to the COVID-19 outbreak and resulting travel restrictions worldwide, ICLP is offering an online track for students who may have difficulties traveling to Taiwan for the 2020 Summer Program. Admitted students may choose to enroll in either the Physical Track or Online Track, and must inform ICLP of their decision by **May 3, 2020**.

Physical Track	3 group classes + 1 one-on-one class per day	US\$4,850
Online Track	2 customized one-on-one classes per day	US\$4,000

This Online Track package is only available for the 2020 Summer Program to students located outside of Taiwan.

For students who choose the Online Track, ICLP provides only one-on-one classes to ensure the highest learning quality and prevent any potential technical issues from disrupting a group class. The two one-on-one classes are expected to cover approximately the same amount of material as the Physical Track. The entire class time would be fully concentrated on one student's learning instead of being divided among three or four students.

ICLP will adjust the Online Track tuition on the online application system on May 4, and contact students about the placement test and other course arrangement matters. Should travel restrictions relax and students registered for the Online Track are able to arrive in Taiwan by May 28, those who wish to switch to the Physical Track may do so before **May 28** after paying the tuition difference.

For students who choose to enroll in the Physical Track, but are unsure whether they can come to Taiwan before the Summer Program starts, please keep an eye on the latest [entry restrictions and requirements](#) for foreign travelers to Taiwan: <https://www.boca.gov.tw/cp-220-5081-c06dc-2.html>

While it is hoped that the current travel restrictions will be lifted before the start of the Summer Program, it is recommended that students plan for arrival by **May 28** at the latest for a 14-day quarantine period.

If students enroll in the Physical Track, but are unable to travel to Taiwan due to coronavirus-related restrictions, ICLP is able to offer the following alternatives:

- 1) Deferral of enrollment: Students may choose to start in any quarter of the 2020-2021 academic year; ICLP will hold their deposit/tuition and apply it to the tuition of the quarter in which they enroll.
- 2) Online Track: ICLP will refund any overpaid tuition and contact the student about course arrangement matters. Requests will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis; should there be no teachers or open time slots available, the student would be asked to select one of the other two options instead.
- 3) Full refund of the deposit/tuition, minus a processing fee and bank charges.

*The above options are available before **June 3, 2020**.*
